

**ARIZONA ANTELOPE FOUNDATION**  
**PRONGHORN CAPTURE**  
**PRESCOTT VALLEY/CHINO VALLEY AREA**  
**JANUARY 24-26, 2012**

**Project Location:** We will be working on the Perkins Ranch north of Prescott Valley and east of Chino Valley in Arizona.

**Project Begins:** Tuesday-Thursday, January 24-26<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 AM. This is a three day project; you must work one of the first two construction days (Jan 24-25; Jan 24<sup>th</sup> preferred) to assist with the capture (Jan 26). We will be carpooling to the worksite, so if you arrive after 7:30 AM and miss the caravan you will miss work on the project for that day.

**Project Activity:** We will be constructing 1-2 miles of wing fences, an alley way fence and corral. All fencing will be new for this project and be removed immediately after the capture is completed.

**Project Purpose:** The purpose of this project is to bolster the pronghorn populations with additional numbers and genetic diversity in Units 35A/B (Elgin and San Rafael Valley areas). The pronghorn population in Unit 19A will be kept at a manageable size and allow for continued recruitment of fawns.

**What to Bring:** Work gloves, eye protection, snacks, water and personal gear. Tools will be provided but if you have your own wire cutters, fencing tool, sledge hammer and/or cowboy, please bring them.

**Meals:** Since this project is taking place on a locked private ranch, you will not be able to leave for lunch. Please BRING a sack lunch to eat in the field each day you are attending. Small ice chests can be accommodated when carpooling.

**Directions to Meeting Location:**

**AAF project will be on the Perkins Ranch, Chino Valley.**

From Kingman: Drive east on I-40 to Ashfork, exit and drive south on US 89 to Chino Valley.

From Flagstaff: Drive west on I-40 to Ashfork, exit and drive south on US 89 to Chino Valley.

From Phoenix: Drive north on I-17 to Cordes, exit and drive west on SR 69 towards Prescott, exit and drive north on Fain Rd, continue along Fain Rd which becomes US 89A/Pioneer Parkway and drive west, exit and drive north on US 89 to Chino Valley.
